

David E. West Memorial Scholarship

IMPORTANT NOTICE – Due to the ongoing crisis concerning the coronavirus, it has been decided to extend the deadline to apply for the 2020 David E. West Memorial Scholarship to **August 3, 2020 at 3 p.m.** All materials must be emailed to parbitell@njpa.org **no later than August 3.**

General Information:

The David West Memorial Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to an outstanding collegiate journalist, attending one of the four colleges/universities located in Mercer County and who has demonstrated an interest in their student newspaper or news site.

The scholarship honors the memory of David E. West, a former Rhodes Scholar and long-time editor of the Trenton Times. During his lengthy career at the Times, David served as suburban editor, assistant city editor, assistant managing editor, managing editor and executive editor. He retired in 1975 and passed away in 1986. As part of her Will, his wife, Florence Block West, asked the scholarship be established upon her death. Mrs. West died in 2013.

This scholarship is open to all journalism majors and/or staff members of news publications at one of the four college/universities in Mercer County (Princeton University, Rider University, The College of New Jersey and Mercer County Community College). **Students who received any New Jersey Press Foundation scholarship in 2019 are not eligible for the 2020 West Scholarship.**

Applicants must deliver, via email, a copy of the application form and all attachments (see below) to parbitell@njpa.org by Monday, August 6 at 3 p.m. Applications will be judged by editors of New Jersey Press Association member newspapers under the direction of the New Jersey Press Foundation.

Application Requirements:

Submit all of these items, in a single email, as attachments.

1. The application form, complete with all information requested. PDF preferred.
2. A copy of your academic transcript(s) for all college course work completed through December 2019. PDF preferred.
3. Three samples of journalistic writing that either appeared in any newspaper or were completed as class assignments. For articles that appeared in print, we prefer PDFs of the pages. For class assignments, Microsoft Word-compatible documents or PDFs are preferred.
4. A statement of your interest in a journalism career, written as an autobiographical sketch describing your journalistic skills and achievements (500 words or less). Word-compatible or PDF preferred.
