General Information

The Richard Drukker Memorial Scholarship is a \$2,000 award to be used to help pay for a Montclair State University student's MSU costs for the fall 2009 semester.

This scholarship program is open to all journalism minors and/or staff members of *The Montclarion*. Students who applied for, but didn't win, any other New Jersey Press Foundation scholarship to be awarded in 2008 also are eligible for the Drukker scholarship.

Applicants must deliver the completed application form and all attachments (see below) to the English Department office no later than 4 p.m., Friday, March 13. The English Department will send all of the applications to the New Jersey Press Foundation for judging in March by a panel of newspaper editors.

The scholarship recipient will be recognized at the English Department's annual awards event.

Parts Required for a Complete Application

1. The application form.
2. Academic transcript(s) for all college course work completed through December 2008. The transcript doesn't have to be an official one with the university seal.
3. Three samples of journalistic writing that has appeared in any newspaper or was done for class assignments. Please tape clippings so they fit on 8 1/2 by 11 paper.
4. A statement of your interest in a newspaper career, written as an autobiographical sketch describing your journalistic skills and achievements (500 words or less). This typed statement(essay) should be double-spaced.
5. Statement of special financial or family circumstances (optional). This statement also should be typed and double-spaced.
